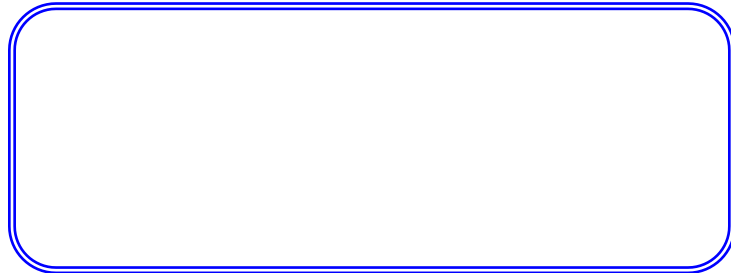



San Juan 21 Sailboats Western States competition at Tenmile Lake

Friday and Saturday brought sailboat competitors from the Western states to Tenmile Lake for regional competition of the San Juan 21 class. The regatta is the Western Nationals for the San Juan 21 Association which rotates the competition between four western locations. A total of 23 boats competed in two classes of racing. The working sails class races with a standard jib and main sail while the all sails class races with a spinnaker, jib or genoa, and mail sails. The Friday races battled strong winds with significant gusts. Tenmile Lake is notorious for very shifty winds coming over the hills. The regatta consisted of three races Friday and two races on Saturday with each over an hour of sailing a course around a series of buoys on South Tenmile Lake. The local hosts were the sailors of San Juan 21 Fleet 43 of Coos Bay Yacht Club. In the working sails competition of 18 boats local boats took the five of the top six places. Local sailors are very competitive at home or traveling to other regions. One entry came from Florida, another from North Carolina and three from Washington state. Several of the top placeholders have won past National competitions.

- 1st Place Sean Randle of North Bend with crew Jessica Randle
- 2nd Place Tom Mills of North Bend with crew Laura Mills of Bellingham, Washington
- 3rd Place Mike Rodde of Abbotsford, British Columbia and crew Carrie O'Bryan of Lakeside
- 4th Place Oscar Barney of Portland with crew John Barney of Coos Bay
- 5th Place Tom Kyle of Coos Bay with crew Dannett Johnson of North Bend
- 6th Place Jon Richards of North Bend with crew Kathy Richards

The All Sails class drew five out of state competitors from Washington and California. Local sailors are not keen on the all sails competition because of the nature of shifty winds locally.

- 1st Place Ruth Barcus and husband crew. Ruth has been competing for over 40 years and has won most of the San Juan Western Nationals in the all sails class.
- 2nd Place Chris Popich of Seattle, Washington.
- 3rd Place Mike Dukes of Auburn, Washington

Next years regatta is scheduled to take place at Huntington Lake, California.

Maintain Safe Drinking Water

Trailer owners will notice a small device attached to their faucet. This is a "back flow preventer" to assist in maintaining the integrity and safety of our water system. It is a required installation at CBYC. You will notice it cannot be removed from the faucet without removing the faucet because it has a set screw permanently in place on the side. Notice on the underside is holes, when the device experiences back flow from the trailer (may be momentary) water will escape from the holes, usually in small amounts. You do **NOT** have a leaky faucet; the device is working correctly to protect the water system. This installation along with chlorination is essential to having a quality and safe water system for our use.



To Save Life...

At CBYC there has been some discussion of acquiring an AED (Automatic Electronic Defibrillator) on site as support for a First Aid response for members and all present. This device is more common in today's society and workplace where groups are present and we should have one, too, since the club is somewhat distance from emergency care. Modern units are easy and simple to use by laymen with "voice prompts" and are a part of Red Cross First Aid and CPR courses. CBYC could also have some training. The useful application of an AED as a first aid device should be considered for all ages as they come with pads for youth.



This proposal is to fund a purchase of an AED unit outside of normal CBYC funds through individual donations and our represented San Juan 21 Fleet, MC Scow Fleet and Geary 18 Fleet. AED Units cost between \$1500 - 1800. If so inclined membership contributed \$25 each and the fleets a few hundred each, it would be funded!

If you have interest in this proposal please speak to it at the next Aug 21 potluck indicating your support to better gauge the potential for funding success.
