March 2, 2011

MEMBERS PRESENT

Correspondence:

1. Johnnie and Lynn Beckett asked that their membership not be renewed.
2. Colleen Cardas requested that her membership be moved from full to Associate membership.

Treasurer: Money is coming in as members pay their dues and fees on time. A new wheelbarrow was purchased.

Race-Claudia Moore reports that the schedule is complete and will be included in the new yearbook. A copy will be in the Yacht YaK.

Junior Sailing- Commodore's Cup dinner is being organized by the Junior Sailors. Some items for the dinner have been donated.

Club House- The floor tile in the kitchen area of the clubhouse gets quite slippery. Richard is going to test an area with a new product to see if the problem can be solved.

Moorings and Docks- A bid was received for the replacement of the one broken piling (near slip A-21) for \$1000. There is a second piling (near slip A-24) that is weak. After discussion a motion was made to approve the spending of up to \$1800 to replace the two pilings. **Note:** The piling replacement will follow "Best Practices" of Marine Standards.

Boat Storage-A new chart will be made to reflect the boat slip assignments.

Roads and Grounds- C.C. reported that the February work party was a great success. There was a good turnout, so much was accomplished. C.C. served the workers a yummy lunch, which was greatly appreciated. The board reviewed the materials list that Drew Miller submitted for the repair and replacement cost of the RV water system.

Social, Adjutant, Nominating, Labor Day, Infrastructure, OAC-no reports

Boat Show-Gordon Gates- The Boat Show is April 1st. Contact Gordon Gates if you are bringing in a boat. He is making a sign for each boat that gives a little information about it. There will be a sign-up for members to man the show all day Saturday and Sunday for 1-2 hour shifts.

Membership-Dick Vigue- Two membership applications were submitted. Kenneth & Wendy Labrouse have applied for full membership. Their two children are Rose, 11 years and William, 7 years. They are being sponsored by Scott and Shannon Randle. The second applicant is Gavin Murdock, 13 years old. He is applying for a Junior membership. His parents are Randy & Christal Murdock. He is being sponsored by his Uncle Richard & Aunt Wendy Rudder. A vote for full membership for the Labrouse family will be held at the April general meeting.

Safety Director and Safety Boat-George Tinker George has received the marine event permit from the Oregon State Marine Board. A copy of this permit will be in the race shack. It shows that the Marine Board has a schedule of all races

and Regattas that we have on the lake, including SJ Nationals and Geary-18 Internationals. This is done annually.

Reminder: Members need to be sure and look over their boats at launch for invasive species. Visiting boats will be looked over before launching also.

Year Book-Shannon Randle The Year Book was sent to the printer this week. A sample will be printed and given to the committee for review.

Old Business

1. The granite is to be fixed next Saturday.

3. The temporary RV site fee box will be installed at the next work party.
4. Timber- there is timber that is infested. Can it be harvested? Adjutant is looking into this for us.

New Business

1. Ship's Store is inactive. Shannon and C.C. stated they would be interested in taking it over and filling stock again if no one else was doing it.
2. At the next general meeting, members will be receiving their keys and yearbooks. **Members will not receive their keys and books if their dues are not paid.**
3. Osprey Point has house rentals available by the week at reasonable rates.
4. George Tinker informed us of some Bills that are being put before the legislature- consolidating the Parks Dept. with the Marine Board is one.
5. There is an extra roof section and there was discussion of how it could be used. One idea is to make a cover for the safety boat. This could be done when the new docks are built.

CBYC Members: Here's your chance to learn to row!

Basic instruction in how to scull a racing shell will be offered to CBYC club members on May 21, 22 and 23. Individualized classes will be offered, one for each of 8 club members registering in advance. Classes will convene at the racing shells above the boat launch at the following times:

Saturday morning, May 21 at 6:00, 7:30 and 9:00.

Sunday morning, May 22 at 7:30 and 9:00.

Monday morning, May 23 at 6:00, 7:30 and 9:00.

There is no fee. All equipment will be provided. You should dress in close-fitting (no bulky jackets) clothing, in layers, so you can peel a layer or two as you warm up. Bring a bottle of water. You'll be rowing in a two-person racing shell called a double (2x). Although flipping a 2x is rare as hen's teeth, it has happened, and since rowers do not wear life vests, you must be able to swim.

CBYC members Don and Karen Costello will provide the instruction. Don taught Karen how to row seven years ago and she has been at it ever since. Don began his rowing career at Cal, where he competed in intercollegiate crew 1966 – '69. During the 1970's, he was varsity crew coach at U. of Oregon, and he founded, and coached, several club and college programs in Portland. A co-founder of one of the clubs, the late Fred McMillan (a former OSU oarsman) was the father of CBYC member Sarah Recken.

After all these years, Don still rows 4 -6 days a week and competes in masters regattas in the U.S. and Canada. He says he has yet to find anything he enjoys more than to sit out in the elements and go backward with gusto! Give it a try! Maybe you'll get the bug as well.
