US Coast Guard Auxiliary offers a Boating Class

The US Coast Guard Auxiliary will conduct an 8 hour boating safety education course monthly in Charleston. The course covers the basics of boating safety, required equipment, rules of the road, and Oregon boating laws. A test at the end of the course will qualify boaters for their Boater Education Card, under the Oregon Mandatory Boater Education Program. The Boater Education Card is required for all motorboat operators of all ages for boats over ten horsepower. Additional provisions apply to youths. The Class is taught by certified US Coast Guard Auxiliary and Oregon State Marine Board instructors. The cost of the course and materials is \$15.

Pre-registration is required.

To register for the class, please call (541) 267-6152.





Note: You need the Mandatory Boaters Safety Education Card to drive the Safety Boat.



This San Juan has been cared for 36 years by an almost original owner at the Coos Bay Yacht Club. The boat raced well competitively yearly on Tenmile Lake near Lakeside, Oregon. The boat has been winter stored under cover. The owner will mentor a new owner at Coos Bay Yacht Club during the summer of 2019.

The boat has an aluminum control bridge above the companion way for cockpit controls of jib, vang, outhaul, downhaul and main sail. The rear stay has compound advantage adjustment and the jib has a simpler compound adjustment. Two Harken winches with adjacent cam cleats are placed for the main sail control and a winch handle are included. The shrouds and chain plate are fastened to an aluminum bulk head plate replacing the original wood. There is quality rigging and cam cleats throughout. Two sets of working sails and a genoa with sail bags are included. Working sails in "like new" to very good condition; all are suitable for racing. A whisker pole, anchor, attached two step ladder, outboard bracket, mooring lines, two paddles, two fenders, throw bag, life jackets, mast crutch, and a trailer (no spare tire) are included. Aft has lazarette storage; forward has a bow pulpit. Four berth cushions are in "like new" condition. The bottom paint is VC 17 applied in 2018. The deck and hull are sound with no soft spots. US Sailing book "The Racing Rules of Sailing" is included.

The boat is located in Coos Bay, Oregon.
